ORAL ORDER

5 06-08-2019 The learned counsel for the parties jointly submit that

the petitioner and opposite party no. 2, who are husband and
wife, have settled the dispute and filed the compromise petition
in the Court of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, I, East
Champaran at Motihari, on 15.02.2019 for permission to
compromise the case, which would appear from Annexure 'A' to
the affidavit filed on behalf of opposite party no. 2.

Since, the matter has been settled out of the Court, let
the petitioner, above named, in the event of surrender/arrest,
within a period of four weeks from today, in connection with
Complaint Case No. C-915 of 2018 shall be released on pre-
arrest bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten



thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, VI, East Champaran at Motihari, or the successor Court subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Criminal Procedure Code.
