The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection
with Samastipur (M) P.S. Case No. 683/2018 registered for the
offence punishable under Sections 307/324/341/504/506/34 of
the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that, save
and except, the allegation against one Vilash Sahani, there is no
role attributed to the present petitioners.
