2 25-04-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with
Sitamarhi P.S. Case No. 28 of 2019, registered for the offence
punishable under Section 461,379,411 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has no criminal antecedent. Allegation against his
petitioner is that he was involved in the theft from the godown
of the informant. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner is in custody since 10.01.2019.

Considering the fact that petitioner has no criminal
antecedent, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.
Let the petitioner named above be released on bail on furnishing



bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sitamarhi, in connection with Sitamarhi P.S. Case No. 28 of 2019.
