Petitioner seeks bail in **Amas P.S. Case No.151 of 2018** instituted for the offence under Section(s) 392 Indian Penal Code.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is not named in the First Information Report. No Test Identification Parade has been held. No incriminating article has been recovered from his possession. Name of the petitioner has come during investigation in the confessional statement of Sanjay Kumar Sinha.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that Petitioner is in custody since 21.12.2018.

Counsel for the petitioner further submits that co-



accused, Sonu Kumar @ Vikash, has already been granted regular bail by co-ordinate Bench of this Court by order dated 25.04.2019 passed in Cr. Misc. No.27226 of 2019.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of the petitioner for grant of bail is allowed. Let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the **Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sherghati, Gaya**, in connection with **Amas P.S. Case No.151 of 2018**, subject to the condition that both the bailors shall be close relative of the petitioner.
