ORAL ORDER

3 21-08-2019 This application, for grant of anticipatory bail,

arises out of Kudhani (O.P. Turki) P.S. Case No. 418/18,

disclosing offences under Sections 394. 302 and 414 of the

Indian Penal Code.

Prosecution case is that brother of the informant had

gone with the truck later on his dead body was recovered near

Dariyapur Kafan and it appears that somebody looted and took

away the truck after killing the brother of the informant and

thrown the dead body of the deceased. Petitioner is not named in

the F.I.R., his name transpired in this during course of

investigation.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is

that he has been made accused in this case only on the



confession of two co-accused persons and except that there is nothing against the petitioner to connect him with the present case.

Learned counsel for the State opposed the prayer for bail and submitted that for further investigation in this case presence of petitioner is required and as such, he does not deserve the privilege of anticipatory bail.

Having heard both sides, considering the facts and circumstances of the case, I am not inclined to grant the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner rather petitioner may surrender before the court below and make prayer for regular bail and if any such application is filed, the court below will dispose of the same on the merit of the case, without being prejudiced by this order.

This application is, accordingly, dismissed.
