2 15-05-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Chanpatia P.S. Case No. 316 of 2018 registered under
Sections 323, 324, 341, 307 and 504/34 of the Indian Penal
Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioner submits that petitioner is a lady. She has no criminal
antecedent. Both the parties are close agnates. Further
submission is that earlier a case was also filed on behalf of the
daughter of the petitioner against the informant, as evident from
Annexure-3. Thereafter, the present case has been lodged.
Moreover, the injury is found simple in nature.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of



the case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the A.C.J.M.-V, West Champaran, Bettiah in connection with Chanpatia P.S. Case No. 316 of 2018, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
