2 30-04-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and

learned counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioners are seeking anticipatory
bail in connection with Complaint Case No. 583 (C) of 2018,
registered for the offence under Sections 323, 498A and 504 of
the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation has been made that accused persons
used to torture the complainant on account of non-fulfillment of
demand of dowry.

The petitioners are father-in-law and mother-in-law
of the complainant.



Looking to the aforesaid facts, let the above-named petitioners be released on anticipatory bail in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the S.D.J.M., Masaurhi, Patna, in connection with Complaint Case No. 583 (C) of 2018, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
