State.

The petitioner seeks bail in **Jainagar P.S. Case No. 51 of 2019**, instituted for the offence under Section(s) 272, 273, 414/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 30(a) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

It is alleged in the written report that 9 liters of country made liquor has been recovered from possession of the petitioner.

Petitioner is in custody since 2.2.2019.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of the petitioner for grant of bail is allowed. Let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two



sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of **learned Additional District & Sessions Judge-2nd & Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Madhubani**, in connection with **Jainagar P.S. Case No. 51 of 2019**, subject to the condition that both the bailors will be the close relatives of the petitioner.

It is mentioned in paragraph-3 of the bail petition that six Excise cases are pending against the petitioner. **Petitioner will file affidavit at the time of furnishing bail bonds that he will not indulge in such type of activity in future, failing which, the bail bonds of the petitioner in the instant case will liable to be cancelled.**
