Petitioner seeks bail in connection with Kalyanpur  
P.S. Case No. 93 of 2018 registered for the offence punishable  
under sections 302, 201/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner  
submits that petitioner is not named in the first information  
report and he has been implicated in this case on basis of the  
confessional statement of the co-accused. Save and except  
suspicion, there is no material against this petitioner showing  
complicity in the alleged crime. Petitioner has no criminal

case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let



the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of 9<sup>th</sup> Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, East Champaran at Motihari in connection with Kalyanpur P.S. Case No. 93 of 2008.
