counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with
Amnour P.S. Case No. 29 of 2019 for the offences under
Sections 413, 414/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since
07.02.2019. He further submits that allegation against this
petitioner is that he was involved in the business of sale of
stolen motorcycle.

Considering the fact that petitioner has no criminal
antecedent, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner,
let the petitioner, named above, be released on bail on furnishing
bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two



sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court of
learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Saran at Chapra in connection
with Amnour P.S. Case No. 29 of 2019.
