4 25-07-2019 This is an application for grant of anticipatory bail in connection with Hasanpur P.S. Case No. 251 of 2018, disclosing offences under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 325, 307, 447, 354B, 109, 379 of IPC.

There is specific allegation against the petitioner that he assaulted by rod to the informant, causing injury.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that there is a land dispute between the parties and the injuries are simple in nature, which will appear from the Annexure 2 to this application.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides, considering the above submission, this application is allowed. Let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the



court below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M.III, Rosera, Samastipur, in connection with Hasanpur P.S. Case No. 251 of 2018, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
