2 02-05-2019 Heard learned counsels for the petitioners and
the State.

Petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with Barignia P.S. Case No. 188 of 2018 registered for the offence punishable under section 307 and other allied sections of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that the allegations levelled against these petitioners are general and omnibus in nature. They have been falsely implicated in this case due to dirty village politics. Petitioners are men of clean antecedent.



Learned Addl. P.P. appearing for the State opposes the prayer for bail and submits that petitioners are named accused in the first information report and there is specific allegation of assault by means of farsa and iron rod against them. During investigation, materials have come showing complicity of these petitioners in the alleged crime.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, this Court is not inclined to grant the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Their prayer for grant of anticipatory bail is, therefore, rejected.
