2 04-09-2019 The order of punishment which has been assailed in

the instant proceeding is passed by the District Magistrate,

Kaimur at Bhabua.

Apart from the fact that the counsel for the State has
raised objection on account of the petitioner's admission in
response to second show cause. It is also submitted that if at all
petitioner had any ground, he should have approached the
appellate authority i.e. Commissioner, Patna, respondent no. 2.

In view of the aforesaid submissions, this court is of the
opinion that the petitioner has statutory, alternative and adequate
remedy to approach the respondent no. 2. If the petitioner
approaches the appellant authority within two weeks from today,



the respondent no. 2 would be obliged to consider the same in accordance with law on its merit without raising the issue of same being time barred. It is expected that he would be disposed of the matter expeditiously and without any undue delay.

The instant writ petition is disposed of.
