The petitioner is in custody in connection with Sirdala
P.S. Case No. 119 of 2019 for the offence under Section 30(a) of
the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has got no criminal antecedent and he is in custody
since 17.03.2019. He further submits that in the instant case
total 60 liters liquor was seized.
