2 25-07-2019 This is an application for grant of anticipatory bail in connection with Chainpur P.S. Case No. 345 of 2018, disclosing offences under Sections 147, 148, 149, 324, 307, 504, 506 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

Allegation against the petitioner is that they along with several other accused persons made indiscriminate firing, causing injury to the brother of the informant.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioners is that there is case and counter case between the parties and the injury report disclosed that brother of the informant has only one fire arm injury.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.



Having heard both sides, considering the above submission, this application is allowed. Let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M.-II, Bhabhua, in connection with Chainpur P.S. Case No. 345 of 2018, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
