that the case of the petitioner is fully covered by a judgment rendered by a coordinate Bench of this Court in CWJC No. 17670 of 2017, reported in ***PLJR 2018(3) 1029 (Akhilanand Singh & ors. vs. The State of Bihar & Ors.)***.

The learned senior counsel for the respondent University submits that the University would examine the case of the petitioner in light of the aforesaid judgment and take a



final decision after verifying the records.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed off with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondent no. 6 by filing appropriate representation within a period of four weeks from today and in case such a representation is filed, the respondent no. 6 shall dispose off the same by a reasoned and speaking order within a period of eight weeks thereafter.
