the State.

Petitioners apprehend arrest in connection
with Special Case No. 392 of 2019 registered for the offence
punishable under sections 30(a), 30(C), 37(C) of the Bihar
Prohibition and Excise Act.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners
submits that petitioners have been falsely implicated in this
case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious
possession of these petitioners. Petitioners are poor persons



having no criminal antecedent.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of 2nd Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Araria in connection with Special Case No. 392 of 2019 arising out of Tarabari P.S. Case No. 51 of 2019 subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
