2 02-09-2019 In view of the concurrent finding of facts on all issues raised by the petitioners by both the Debts Recovery Tribunal, Patna as well as the Appellate Authority at Allahabad, this court finds no reason to take upon itself the exercise of a fact finding body.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are still willing to settle the account with the Bank. If it is so, they are at liberty to approach the



Bank and the Bank authority shall consider the request of the petitioners keeping in view their policy decision and the recovery policy.

No interference in the impugned order is required. The writ application stands dismissed.
