2 03-05-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with
Sahebganj P.S. Case No.70 of 2019 for the offences under
Sections 272, 273, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Sections
30(a) (g), 33, 34(b), 35(a), 36, 41(a)(2) of the Bihar Prohibition
and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at the
relevant time the petitioner was in custody and nothing was
recovered from his possession and as such he was not involved
in the commission of offence. He further submits that petitioner
is not connected with the trade of liquor and he is in custody
since 26.03.2019. He further submits that in the instant case
total 1293 liters liquor was seized.



Considering the fact that at the relevant time petitioner was in custody, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Let the petitioner, named above, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Excise Act, Muzaffarpur, in connection with Sahebganj P.S. Case No.70 of 2019.
