2 02-05-2019 Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the
State.

Petitioner apprehends arrest in connection
with Samastipur Town P.S. Case No. 313 of 2018 registered
for the offence punishable under sections 406, 420, 467,
468, 471 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner
submits that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this
case due to previous enmity. The present complaint has been
lodged after 5 months of the alleged occurrence without
there being any plausible explanation for the delay. The
dispute involved is purely civil in nature. Petitioner has no
criminal antecedent.



Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Samastipur in connection with Samastipur Town P.S. Case No. 313 of 2018 subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
