Let the petitioner, above-named, in the event of arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, be released on bail upon furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned SDJM, Samastipur in connection with Complaint Case/CR No. 147 of 2018; subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
