2 13-05-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Barhara (Krishangarh) P.S. Case No. 83 of 2019 for the
offence punishable under Sections 366(A) and 34 of the
Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner
submits that the petitioner, who is of clean antecedent, is
innocent and has not committed any offence. In fact, there is
general and omnibus allegation against the petitioner rather
the specific allegation is attributed to co-accused Ritesh
Paswan, who is brother of this petitioner. This petitioner has
no concern with the alleged occurrence. Hence, the



petitioner may be granted the privilege of anticipatory bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the, above named, petitioner in the event of surrender within a period of four weeks be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M., Bhojpur at Ara in connection with Barhara (Krishangarh) P.S. Case No. 83 of 2019 subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
