2 13-05-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offence punishable under Section 395 of the Indian Penal Code.

The FIR of the occurrence of dacoity is against
unknown.

Submission is that petitioner is in custody since
16.07.2018. However, he was never put on Test Identification
Parade during investigation of the case nor anything was
recovered from possession of the petitioner. Only on the basis of
two criminal cases against the petitioner, he has been falsely
implicated in this case.

Considering the fact that there is no material for
refusal of bail, let the petitioner, above named, be released on
bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty



Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Bangaon Police Station Case No. 141 of 2017, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
