2 01-05-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with
Bhargama P.S. Case No. 18 of 2019 for the offences under
Sections 147, 148, 144, 149, 152, 186, 188, 342, 323, 325, 307,
353, 467, 468, 471, 332, 329, 337, 504, and 506/34 of the Indian
Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since
29.01.2019. He further submits that allegation against this
petitioner is that he was involved in forcefully constructing
temple.

Considering the fact that petitioner has no criminal



antecedent and he has remained in custody for more than three months, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, let the petitioner, named above, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Araria in connection with Bhargama P.S. Case No. 18 of 2019.
