2 14-05-2019 Heard learned counsels for the petitioners and
the State.

Petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with Rajpur P.S. Case No. 315 of 2018 registered for the offence punishable under sections 363, 366A of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case at the instance of their enemies. As a matter of fact, the victim girl has been recovered and she in her statement under section 164 Cr.P.C. (Annexure-2) has admitted that she left her hosue with her sweet will and has solemnized marriage with Pappu Kumar and has not stated anything



against this petitioners. Petitioners are men of clean antecedent.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, VII, Buxar in connection with Rajpur P.S. Case No. 315 of 2018 subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
