3 17-05-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the

learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Complaint Case No. 160 of 2018 for the offence punishable under Sections 323, 406, 498/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that the petitioners, who are of clean antecedent, are innocent and have not committed any offence. In fact, the



petitioners happen to be father-in-law, mother-in-law and younger brother-in-law of the complainant. The have no concern with the marital affairs of the complainant and her husband because they live separately. Hence, the petitioners may be granted the privilege of anticipatory bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the, above named, petitioner in the event of surrender within a period of four weeks be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M., Samastipur in connection with Complainant Case No. 160 of 2018 subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
