5 03-04-2019 The present petition has been filed for adding Patna, Buxar and B.M.P.-2 as places from where the petitioner had applied for appointment on the post of Constable vide Advertisement No. 01/04 and 02/04, in the original writ petition bearing CWJC No. 9780 of 2011.

This Court finds that after a lapse of about 15 years, modification being sought to be made in the original writ petition, cannot be permitted since the rights of parties might have crystallized in the meantime, hence the modification petition is dismissed.
