5 26-06-2019 The consequential benefits quantified at Rs. 83,736/-

has been paid to the petitioner. The position has not been
disputed rather Mr. Rajesh Kumar Sharma, learned counsel
appearing for the petitioner complains of denial of promotion.

The order passed on the writ petition gives no such
direction to the respondents for issuing order of promotion. In
case the petitioner feels that he is entitled to consideration of his



case for promotion, he may raise his grievance before the appropriate authority and which shall be considered and disposed in accordance with law but in circumstances discussed, no case for contempt is made.

The contempt application is disposed of accordingly.
