2 30-04-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with
Sessions Trial No. 92 of 2017, Kunauli P.S. Case No. 42 of 2016
for the offences under Sections 399, 402, 411 of the Indian
Penal Code and Section 25(1-b)A, 26, 35 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since
24.09.2016. He further submits that petitioner is accused in
other cases but the fact remains that the petitioner has remained
in custody for more than two years and seven months.

Considering the period of custody for more than two
years and seven months, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the
petitioner, let the petitioner, named above, be released on bail on



furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, 4th, Supaul in connection with Sessions Trial No. 92 of 2017, Kunauli P.S. Case No. 42 of 2016 with the condition that petitioner shall attend the court proceeding on each and every day and in case he fails to attend the Court proceedings without any cogent reason, the Court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond.
