4      26-07-2019      Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP for the  
State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest for the offences alleged  
under Sections 498A of the Indian Penal Code and Section 4 of the D.P.  
Act registered in connection with Complaint Case No. 588C of 2018.

3. It is submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated and  
this is the first complaint of its nature since the petitioner and the  
informant were married as far back as in the year 2014. The petitioner  
expresses his readiness to keep the informant with due dignity and  
honour and submits that it is the informant who is not willing to live  
with him. The petitioner claims clean antecedents.

4. Despite valid service of notice on OP No. 2 none is present on  
her behalf when the matter is called.

5. Be that as it may, in the event of the petitioner's arrest or  
surrender before the court below within six weeks from the date of  
communication of this order, let the above named petitioner be  
released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand)  
with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned  
SDJM, Araria in connection with Complaint Case No. 588C of 2018,



subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and also subject to the following further conditions:

- i. That one of the bailors shall be a close relative of the petitioner.
- ii. That the petitioner shall not indulge in any similar offence till conclusion of the trial.
- iii. The petitioner shall remain physically present in Court on each and every date during trial and in the event of failure on two consecutive dates without sufficient reason, his bail bond shall be liable to be cancelled by the learned Court concerned.
