counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with Rosera
P.S. Case No. 61 of 2019 for the offence under Sections 272,
273/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 30(a) of the Bihar
Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has got no criminal antecedent and he is in custody
since 16.03.2019. He further submits that in the instant case
total 12 liters liquor was seized.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has got no
criminal antecedent, the petitioner, named above, is directed to
be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/-
