4 17-07-2019 The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the only grievance of the petitioner left to be redressed is regarding payment of revised unutilized leave encashment amount as well as the arrears of salary.

The learned counsel appearing for the respondents submits that he has received instructions and according to his instructions, the amount on the head of arrears of salary has already been credited to the account of the petitioner and as far as the revised unutilized leave encashment amount is concerned,



the same has been sanctioned and will be paid within a period of four weeks from today.
