Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is permitted to make necessary
correction in the prayer portion.

In this case, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail
in connection with Konch P.S. Case No. 78 of 2019 registered
for offence punishable under section 30(a) of the Bihar
Prohibition Excise Act, 2016.

It has been alleged that two litres of illegal liquor has
been recovered from the friend of the petitioner, not from the
possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has clean antecedent.

Looking to the facts and circumstances of the case,
the prayer for bail of the petitioner is allowed and he, in the
event of arrest or surrender before the court below within six



weeks from today, is directed to be enlarged on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Special Judge, Excise, Gaya in connection with Konch P.S. Case No. 78 of 2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438 Cr. PC and also subject to the condition that one of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court. The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence. The petitioner shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court.
