2      06-05-2019                      The present writ petition has been filed for directing the respondents to grant grade pay of Rs. 4800/- to the petitioner w.e.f. March, 2013, since the teachers, junior to the petitioner have already been granted the said benefit. The petitioner further prays for being granted promotion to the post of



Headmaster.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case, he is permitted to file a representation regarding his grievances mentioned in the writ petition, before the respondent no. 8.

Accordingly, it is directed that the petitioner may file a representation before the respondent no. 8 within a period of four weeks from today and the respondent no. 8 shall dispose of the same by a reasoned and speaking order within a period of eight weeks thereafter considering the judgment dated 20.01.2018 passed by the co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWJC no. 2399 of 2016.

The writ petition is disposed off on the aforesaid terms.
