The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Warisnagar P.S. Case No. 299/2018 registered for the offense punishable under Sections 323/341/353/379/427/448/452/504/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that considering the patent anomaly in the registration of the case under Section 353 of the I.P.C. and the contents of the F.I.R. as detailed therein raises doubt on the prosecution story, let the petitioners No. 1 and 2 (above named) be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a



period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Samastipur, in connection with Warisnagar P.S.
