2 13-05-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the

learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Barachatti P.S. Case No. 56 of 2019 for the offence
punishable under Sections 30(d) of the Bihar Prohibition
and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner
submits that the petitioner, who is of clean antecedent, is
innocent and has not committed any offence. In fact, nothing
has been recovered from the conscious possession of the
petitioner which is evident from the seizure list itself. The
petitioner is owner of the alleged motorcycle but he has no
concern with the alleged recovery of Mahua. Hence, the



petitioner may be granted the privilege of anticipatory bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the, above named, petitioner in the event of surrender within a period of four weeks be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Special Judge, Excise Act, Gaya in connection with Barachatti P.S. Case No. 56 of 2019 subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
