ORAL ORDER

9 28-08-2019 On account of passing of strict order by this Court, finally the outstanding retiral dues of the petitioner has stood paid, however, it is submitted on behalf of the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner that though the petitioner had retired on 31.07.2009, outstanding retiral dues have been paid only in the year 2018-19.
