counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioners are seeking anticipatory
bail in connection with Bandhwa Karawa P.S. Case No. 12 of
2018, registered for the offence punishable under Sections 341,
323, 379, 307, 504, 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioners is to have
assaulted the son of informant with *Lathi*, however, learned
counsel for the petitioners submits that there is no specific
allegation of committing overt act against the petitioners. The
petitioners are ladies having no criminal antecedent.

Looking to the entire facts and circumstances of the



case, let the petitioners, above-named, be released on anticipatory bail in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Banka, in connection with Bandhwa Karawa P.S. Case No. 12 of 2018, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
