APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under
Section 395 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation is that a dacoity was committed in the
house of the informant and miscreants looted away cash Rs.1.15
lacs, ornaments and clothes.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
the petitioner is in custody since 17.12.2018. Charge sheet has
been submitted in this case. There is no allegation of tampering
of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The petitioner is not
named in the F.I.R. His name has come on confessional
statement of co-accused There is no recovery of any
incriminating article from the possession of the petitioner. The



petitioner has not been put on T.I.P. It is further submitted that the petitioner may be released on bail after completion of one year in custody from 17.12.2018.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is not named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let **the petitioner, above named, be released on bail after completion of one year in custody from 17.12.2018** on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M. VIII, Bhojpur (Ara) in connection with Agiaon Bazar P.S. case No.05 of 2018.
