2 03-05-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with
Sheohar P.S. Case No. 212 of 2018 for the offences under
Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner is that petitioner was
involved in illegal withdrawal of the amount from the bank
account of the informant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and the
petitioner is Sweeper in the bank. He further submits that the
name of the petitioner was surfaced on the basis of confessional
statement of co-accused Akash Kumar and he is in custody since
19.02.2019.



Considering the fact that name of the petitioner was surfaced on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused Akash Kumar, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Let the petitioner, named above, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sheohar, in connection with Sheohar P.S. Case No. 212 of 2018.
