Heard learned counsel for the petitioner; learned AC to AAG 15 for the State and learned counsel for the Magadh University (hereinafter referred to as the 'University').

2. In view of materials on record, the Court finds that the order of the Court dated 10.05.2016 passed in CWJC No. 17828 of 2014 has been complied with.

3. Accordingly, the application stands disposed off.



4. However, with regard to the admissibility of 12 per cent interest on dues of Provident Fund, when the University has granted only 5 per cent, it shall be open to the petitioner to assail the same before the appropriate forum, in accordance with law.
