2 31-07-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in Ujiyarpur P.S. Case No. 233/2018, registered for the offences punishable under Section 302/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. There is no eye-witness of the occurrence. Name of this petitioner figured in this case on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused Nitish Kumar. Save and except disclosure made by co-accused, there is nothing against this petitioner. Petitioner has got clean antecedent.

Considering the facts aforesaid, the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest/surrender before the court



below within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Dalsingsarai, Samastipur in connection with Ujiyarpur P.S. Case No. 233/2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
