2 07-05-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in connection with Sirdala P.S. Case No. 29 of 2019, registered for the offence punishable under Section 406, 420, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation has been made that the petitioner, in spite of specific direction, did not deposit the folder and record in connection with appointment of teachers, however, counsel for the petitioner submits that he has already deposited the concerned folder and record on 5.03.2019 to the District Programme Officer (Establishment), Nawada.

Looking to the entire facts and circumstances of the



case, let the petitioner, above-named, be released on anticipatory bail in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the A.C.J.M.-V, Nawada in connection with Sirdala P.S. Case no.29 of 2019, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
