This application under Article 215 of the Constitution of India and Sections 10,11,12 of the Contempt of Courts Act has been filed by the petitioner for initiating a contempt proceeding against the opposite parties on account of non-compliance of the judgment dated 23.03.2017 passed in C.W.J.C. No.1225 of 2015.
