3 14-08-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered for the offence punishable Section 30(a) of the Bihar
Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is
no recovery from the conscious possession of the petitioner and
also there is no compliance under Section 100 of the Cr.P.C.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, let the
petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender
before the Court below within a period of six weeks from the
date of receipt of the order, be released on anticipatory bail on
furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) with



two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned VIIIth Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Excise, East Champaran, Motihari in connection with Excise Case No. 84 of 2017, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
