3 14-08-2019 After some arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to file a duly constituted complaint petition before the Insurance Ombudsman in terms of Rule 12 of the Redressal of Public Grievances Rules, 1998 (hereinafter referred to as the 'Rules of 1998') within a period of 30 days from today.

Learned counsel for the Insurance Company has no objection to the same.

This writ application is, thus, disposed off with liberty to the petitioner to file a complaint before the Insurance Ombudsman against the letter of repudiation within a period of



30 days from today and if such a complaint is filed within the aforesaid period, the same will be considered on its own merit in terms of Rule 15 and 16 of the Rules of 1998 and an appropriate order/award shall be passed thereon within the statutory period.

The writ application stands disposed off accordingly.
