ORAL ORDER

10 04-09-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory
bail in connection with Bhagwanpur P.S. Case No.106 of 2011,
registered for the offence punishable under Sections 406 and
420 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation has been made that the petitioner, who is
a PDS dealer, failed to distribute the foodgrains to the
beneficiaries under the SGYP Scheme.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that even after
lapse of 7-8 years, the investigating agency could not complete
the investigation.



Looking to the entire facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, above-named, be released on anticipatory bail in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Siwan in connection with Bhagwanpur P.S. Case No.106 of 2011 subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
