This application, for grant of anticipatory bail, arises out of Katra P.S. Case No. 32 of 2018, disclosing offences under Sections 272 and 273 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 30(a), 36 and 38 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Allegation against the petitioner is of recovery of 52.5 litres of liquor from the tempo and two persons were arrested and it is said that petitioner and others succeeded in fleeing away.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is that he has falsely been implicated in this case and nothing has been recovered from his conscious possession and he has been made accused only on the basis of suspicion.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.



Having heard both sides, in view of the above facts, this application is allowed. Let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.D.J. -II Muzaffarpur-cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Muzaffarpur, in connection with Katra P.S. Case No. 32 of 2018, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure
