2 10-05-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
APP for the State.

Petitioners seek bail in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 302, 120B/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Submission is that husband of petitioner no. 2 died in his matrimonial house by committing suicide. The Doctor has found a case of hanging. The informant, who is father of the deceased, suspects that his murder was committed. Though there is no allegation of motive against petitioner no. 2 or petitioner no. 1, who is mother of petitioner no. 2 for commission of murder.

Considering the nature of allegation and completion of investigation , let the petitioners, above named, be released



on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Barachatti Police Station Case No. 574 of 2018, with the following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned court-below having immovable property.

(b) The petitioners shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioners.
