3 15-07-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under Section
379 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegedly, the motorcycle of the informant, parked near
Marhowrah bridge, was found missing.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that there
is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the
petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 24-03-2019. Charge
sheet has already been submitted. The petitioner is a scrap
dealer. Two stolen motorcycles are said to have been recovered.
The petitioner had no knowledge that the motorcycles in
question are stolen property.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is



named in the Complaint Case/F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-II, Chapra in connection with Marhowrah P.S. Case No. 477 of 2015.
